#### **Teacher's duties:**

The incumbent works independently, but takes direction from and reports directly to the Principal in regards to the tasks and activities that are required to maintain the responsibilities of the position. Teachers are expected to operate with the highest level of confidentiality and must be an expert in implementing elementary education that incorporates current, research-based strategies and programs across the disciplines, for the Simpcw community. This position works with the community members and plays an important role to promote the education, growth and development of the children within the Simpcw First Nation and community. Ability to work in a cross-cultural setting working with the Simpcw Language and Culture team.

#### **Qualifications:**

Must have a current, valid teaching certificate from the B.C. College of Teachers, significant related work experience and knowledge of First Nations history and culture.

Must have a current criminal record check.

#### **Knowledge and Abilities:**

- Ability to work with groups while consistently taking into account the individual needs of all students
- Must have a wide range of teaching skills which will enable them to work with special needs that range from disabled to gifted learners.
- Must have flexibility which will allow for adjustments in teaching strategies to accommodate for current needs - physical, intellectual, and socio-emotional of each student.
- Must possess openness to involving others in the learning process.
- Must possess team teaching skills.
- Strong ability to supervise support staff.
- Must have strong communication skills.

- Must have willingness to work in co-operation with parents to guide parents with homework and educational issues.
- Must possess a willingness and ability to adhere to the curricula developed and affirmed as being most effective for students of Neqweyqwelsten School.
