- Administer immediate first aid and emergency medical care to as per established protocols.
- Assess the nature and extent of injuries or illnesses and provide appropriate medical treatment on-site.
- Record detailed and accurate medical incident reports, including treatment provided and patient information.
- Maintain and restock medical supplies and equipment to ensure readiness for any emergency.
- Collaborate with other safety personnel and staff to enhance overall safety and medical response effectiveness.
- Provide guidance and support in implementing safety measures and protocols at work sites and events.
- Communicate effectively with management and team members to keep them informed about incidents and medical requirements.
- Work in a respectful manner with all team members and corporate departments.
- Stay current with the latest medical best practices and procedures through regular training and skill enhancement programs.
- Participate in medical emergency response drills.

- Valid Occupational First Aid Level 3 (OFA3) certification.
